

Application Form Summary

This summary will help you prepare to complete our online application form. It outlines the sort of questions we will ask and any additional documents you'll need to complete – it is not the application form itself.

GENERAL

We'll ask for details such as your name and contact details, the name and contact details of your parent, guardian or adult who is responsible for you, and the name of your school.

EDUCATION

We'll ask you which education system you are studying in, what subjects you are taking in Year 13, and to outline any academic achievements from secondary school, or any issues that you faced that may have negatively impacted on your Year 12 results. You'll also need to upload a copy of your **academic transcript**. You can talk to your teacher, Dean or Careers Advisor at school about how to do this, or contact NZQA directly on 0800 697 296.

LEADERSHIP

We'll ask you to describe any school and/or community leadership roles you have held in the last two years, and give us some examples of the sorts of activities you took part in.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITY

Let us know what extra-curricular activities you have taken part in over the last two years.

FINANCIAL OR FAMILY CIRCUMSTANCES

You may decide to apply for this scholarship on the basis of financial hardship, difficult personal circumstances, or both. We'll ask you tell us how you think receiving the WRMK Scholarship will have an impact on your ability to study law at university.

If you wish to apply on the basis of financial hardship, we will ask you to complete our **Financial Hardship Questionnaire** with your parent, guardian or responsible adult.

If you wish to apply on the basis of your personal circumstances, we'll ask you to outline any family or personal circumstances that may impact on your ability to study law, for example, whether you are first-in-family to attend university, have a disability, have experienced or are experiencing hardship, or difficult family relationships.

TELL US YOUR WHY

Tell us why you wish to go to university to study law, or to pursue a career in law.

REFEREES

We'll ask you for the names and contact details for 1 referee to support your application, across the areas of leadership, your family's circumstances, academic, or general. Please note you will need to make sure you have the permission of the referee before supplying us with these contact details.
